Judging Schedule

- Exhibitors are asked to bring their own grass mats and paper for use in their exercise pens. **NO SHAVINGS ALLOWED.**
- The flooring in the grooming area is plastic on top of carpet. Use your grass mat on top of the plastic and paper on top of the grass mat.
- The Coast Plaza Hotel airport shuttle cannot accommodate dogs and crates! Airport taxis can accommodate 4 or 5 adult passengers and vans are available upon request to assist customers with excess luggage.
- Show building in the Coast Plaza Hotel Ballroom will be open at **2 PM on Tuesday May 13 2008 for exhibitors to set-up.** No Vehicle will be allowed into the building. Enter through the conference room entry on the West side of the hotel, south corner.
- Vendor Booth Set-up will be through the same doors.
- **All dogs and set ups must be removed from the Show building by 11 am Monday May 19, 2008.**
- Exhibitors are responsible for any damage incurred by themselves or their dogs.
- The Ballroom (the show building) will be open from 6 am to 11 pm each day.
- Any dogs left in the show building when you are absent from the building or overnight **MUST BE CRATED.** All exhibitors are required to leave emergency contact information on your crates or ex-pen in the event of emergency.
- We will supply overnight security. However, the club and the hotel are not responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.
- There is no on call veterinarian but there are veterinarians in the vicinity. Any veterinarian care you require is at your discretion.
- The **Show Superintendent** will be in full charge of the show/trial, which will be governed by KKC rules. Dogs must be on the show grounds one hour prior to the scheduled judging of their breed. Dogs, which are not required for further judging, may be excused. Dogs must be ready for judging. The club and its superintendent will not be responsible and are not obliged to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any

- The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.
- Persons are expected to clean up after their dogs in all circumstances. If you make no effort to clean up after your dog you may be disqualified from that day's show/trial.
- No signs stating dogs/puppies for sale will be allowed on show site.
- No exercise pens permitted in the parking lot or grass areas of the hotel.
- No grooming or bathing of dogs in hotel rooms.
- No un-entered dogs in the show or grooming areas.
- No whelping of bitches at the show site including the hotel.
- No breeding of dogs in the hotel or surrounding premises.
- Dogs must be crated when the owner is out of the room. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while in the hotel lobbies or on the grounds.
- No flash photography at ringside.
- The City of Calgary is considered smoke free. There is no smoking allowed inside any building and City of Calgary by-law does not allow smoking within 5 meters of any public entrance.
- Parents are responsible for children.
- Should the hotel, for cause, deem it necessary to cancel room privileges, the registrant agrees to forgo legal actions against the CSSA, ASSCA or SSFC.
- Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the hotel staff and observed violations or damages will be reported.
- All crates in the grooming area MUST be stackable. NO soft sided crates allowed in the grooming areas.
- No cell phones at ringside.
- Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.
- The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.
- All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.
